

## FAIR eternalised in the Universe

An asteroid which has been discovered in the year 2007 by the two astronomers Erwin Schwab und Rainer Kling in the <u>Taunus-Observatory</u> of the <u>Physical Society Frankfurt</u> has recently been named "FAIR". It took about 3 years for the asteroid No. 204873 to receive this name from the <u>Committee on Small Body Nomenclature (CSBN)</u> and it now recognises the global importance of the new science centre to-be near Darmstadt. During this period of time the <u>Minor Planet Center</u> in den USA carefully checked the properties and the exact location of the new small planet. With a diameter of about 1-2 kilometres it orbits between Mars and Jupiter in our solar system.
